Prior to Departure

Directions from the airport to La Resa.

- 1) Take the bus to Barcelona City Get off at terminal stop (Plaça Espanya)
- 2) From Plaça Espanya , take underground L3 (green line). You can buy a 10 journey ticket for about 8 € at the station. Direction: Zona Universitaria
- 3) Get off at Palau Reial (Station before last)

We will meet the Spanish students **on Monday 17 march, at 8.50 am, at the ETSEIB*** (Escola Tec. Sup. d'Enginyeria Industrial de Barcelona) Universitat Politecnica de Catalunya where you will have breakfast and a welcome meeting with the director. The rest of the week you will reside with your exchange partner.
